A new bibliography of books and articles devoted to medical history. Lists of journals are included according to the code introduced by the British *Journal of Scientific Books* and recently modified by the International Standards Organization.

Many additions suggested in the former edition have been incorporated, and the list of books has been extended towards covering surveys and complements. Williams have also checked many of the detailed references. Mr. H. G. Papadopulos has been given credit for his help in the preparation of the manuscript and the illustrations.

I would like to thank the publishers for permission to hope that the new edition will receive more widespread interest than its predecessor in the past.

the former lists a total of 6,000 entries, consisting of 5,500 selected from Garrison's *Bibliography of Medicine*, and 500 taken from the lists of the present work. Much has been added to the former lists, and to which about one-third have been added new sections, principally of references to subjects and publications which have since been added to the lists. In addition to the original contributions, new sections have been added, together with some minor, though important contributions not included in the original *List*, and an recently published *Index*. Many sections have been enlarged, and minor improvements have been added by those who have contributed to recent editions. As far as possible, the original sources will be followed, though some changes will be made.

INTRODUCTION TO SECOND EDITION

The publication of a second edition of this bibliography has provided the opportunity to close some gaps and to bring the book into line with recent discoveries in medicine. Several sections have been considerably expanded and the whole work has been completely overhauled, although no attempt has been made to come close to the present in all subjects. About 1,400 entries have been added and a few removed. The total number of items (6,808) includes some 3,800 from Garrison's original *Check List*.

Preparation of the first edition was completed during the war, when many of the texts were not accessible for consultation. With the return to normal conditions the majority of these works have again become available, making possible the correction of a number of minor, and a few serious, mistakes.

The general arrangement remains unaltered except that the section on the History of Medicine, now enlarged and subdivided, has been more appropriately placed next to Biography and Bibliography; it now includes a list of periodical publications devoted to medical history. Titles of journals are abbreviated according to the code introduced by the *World List of Scientific Periodicals* and subsequently modified by the International Standards Organization.

Fellow librarians and others interested in the history of medicine have given valuable help towards ensuring accuracy and completeness. In this connexion I should like to thank Dr. S. S. B. Gilder, Mr. W. J. Bishop, Mr. W. R. LeFanu, Mr. L. M. Payne, Mr. F. N. L. Poynter, Mr. T. J. Shields, Miss Agnes Lothian, Mr. John Lothian, Mr. G. J. Hipkins, Miss Gertrude Annan, Mr. R. Eriksson, Dr. H. R. Viets, Dr. K. Reucker, and Dr. F. W. Rieppel. I am particularly indebted to the Librarian of the Royal Society of Medicine for permission to use that library. Mr. S. Watkins and Mr. T. F. Howarth have between them checked more than a thousand references. Technical advice on layout has been given by Mr. H. C. Papadopulo, and my wife has again helped with the preparation of the manuscript and the indexes.

The kind reception given to the previous edition leads me to hope that the present revision will prove even more useful to those interested in the past achievement and future progress of medicine.
